Dear Parents:

The Rock Hill Elementary Local Report Card [<http://ilrc.ode.state.oh.us/>] and/or attached sheet shows how well Rock Hill Elementary did when compared with similar districts.

Although our school was rated effective, we did not meet AYP this year; this is a result of our district not meeting Ohio's goals in Reading and Math on the OAA. In order to be moved out of School Improvement, we will need to meet AYP two consecutive years. Rock Hill Elementary school will address this area by offering ideas on how to meet AYP for two years in a row. You are invited to join us, to serve on a committee or to help us in other ways to accomplish this goal.

To help The Rock Hill Elementary School get out of School Improvement, we have developed a plan to help our students do better in 5th-grade mathematics and reading for the coming year. You are invited to join us to help make that happen. Please contact Eric Floyd at 740-532-7030, if you are interested in being part of a committee or would like more information on ways you can help.

Since the school is still in School Improvement, you have the option of leaving your child at Rock Hill Elementary or transferring your child to another public school or community school not in School Improvement. Ironton City Schools and Symmes Valley Local are unable to accept students through Public School Choice this year.

There may be community schools in our area that are not in improvement, these can also serve as schools of choice under PSC. You may use the community school lookup link: [http://ilrc.ode.state.oh.us/Schools/Comm_School_list.asp] to determine if there are eligible community schools in our area.

If you wish to exercise this public school choice, you should file the attached application no later than September 15, 2011. Applications will be ranked according to need and service provided as money is available. Choice may be limited.
